Presentation abstract

Poison Centres – The Past, Present and Future

National Chemical Emergency Centre (NCEC), will explore the current poison centre landscape and how this is affected by REACH and CLP, specifically the recent update to CLP, Annex VIII, released in March 2017.

Jon will provide an overview of the specific country requirements focusing on the intricacies of registrations such as the varying data requirements and submission processes across different member states. Additionally, looking at how Poison Centre emergency numbers can be used and whether they are mandatory. Jon will also provide updates from the harmonisation working groups on guidance and IT tools and talk about the latest enforcements.
